- 75-question survey instrument
- Developed with bishops, pastors, pastoral ministers, and thought leaders
- Opportunity for parishioners to reflect on two things:
- 1. Engagement with the parish
- 2. Individual spiritual growth



Parishioners' self identified in one of four stages on the Catholic Journey

A compelling survey question

Parishioners self identified in one of 4 stages

- Stage 1: I consider myself Catholic, though faith is not a significant part of my life
- Stage 2: I practice my Catholic faith, but do not know Jesus personally like a friend
- Stage 3: I have personally encountered Jesus Christ and am growing as a disciple
- **Stage 4**: My relationship with Jesus Christ is the most important relationship in my life

The national data was analyzed to determine what is different between stages.







- 3. I shared my personal witness story with another person.



3 Key Outcome Questions and drivers - What areas can you focus on that will:


- increase the "strongly agrees" on those outcome questions and related drivers?





What drives a parishioner to recommend their parish to a friend and to indicate the parish is helping them grow spiritually?



Their Possible Prioritized Areas of Growth

Key Outcome Questions:

Recommend their parish to a friend and the parish is helping them grow spiritually.

Considered increasing the strongly agrees on drivers:

50% - Parish is welcoming

36% - Parish helps me recognize God's work in my life

31% - Parish forms me as a disciple of Jesus



Their Possible Prioritized Areas of Growth

Key Outcome Questions:

Share personal witness story

Considered increasing the strongly agrees on drivers:


23% - Confidence in Church teachings

17% - Equipped to share personal witness story

31% - Equipped to share the story of Jesus



Opportunities top 3 lowest % of strongly agree results



Strengths and Opportunities Report

Their Possible Prioritized Areas of Growth

Strengths and Opportunity Report

Considered increasing the strongly agrees:

- 17% Equipped to share personal witness story
- 23% Confidence in the Church teachings
- 24% Equipped to share the story of Jesus



Bringing Opportunities into Focus

Catholic Journey Concerns:

- I have personally encountered Jesus Christ and am growing as a disciple
- 31% I practice my Catholic faith, but do know Jesus personally like a friend




Bringing Opportunities into Focus

Key Drivers – increasing "strongly agrees" on:

- My parish is welcoming
 ✓
- Parish helps me see God working in my life
- My parish forms me as a disciple
- Confidence in Church teachings
- Parish equips me in sharing my personal story
- Parish equips me in sharing the story of Jesus
